

2013 – collated / surveyed, analysed, formed consensus about recommendations

Continually engaged with policy/regulation for enhanced trade and investment, technology, economic and other advances

More recently analysed 3 EU FTAs in the region (Singapore, Vietnam, Indonesia) – developed a Chapter Chart of likely topics.
