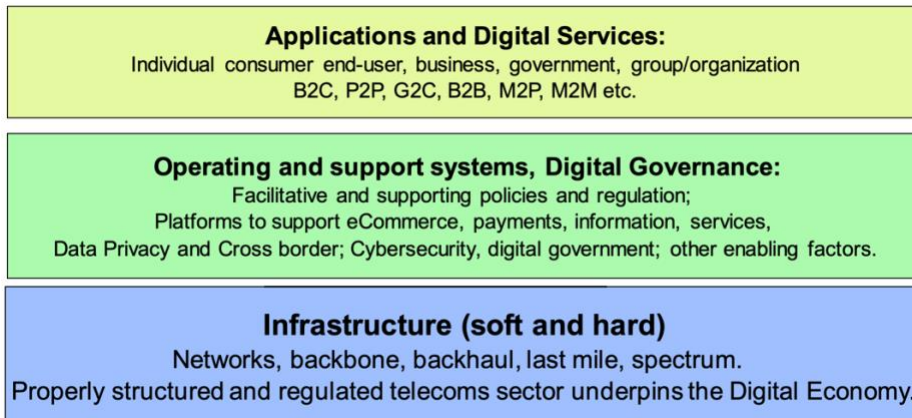


PARTICIPATING IN THE EABC DIGITAL ECONOMY / ICT WORKING GROUP - Feb 2022

The Group covers a wide range of topics, focused and filtered by Objectives. The Group is also a driver of several general topics not wholly within the Digital scope, such as Fast Track Regulatory Reform, some Work Permit & Visa; FBA.

Objectives of the Digital Economy/ICT Working Group

- 1) To be a forum for issues of interest to EABC members on Digital Economy topics
- 2) To be a thought leader and producer of attractive and value-adding solutions on Digital Economy/ICT issues; builder of consensus in the European business community and wider.
- 3) To bring an understanding of relevant EU policies, laws and regulation and world best practice options for resolution of issues and problems.
- 4) To provide a networking and business connection in digital industries for EABC members
- 5) To be an additional catalyst for Being Digital and digitalisation.

Meetings – internal; External engagement

- We meet formally, monthly, by Zoom. 90 mins. We encourage critical thinking, mutual respect in our discourse in striving for optimal solutions and above all, participation.
- The Group is a joint group with the JFCCT Committee of the same name.
- Our advocacy engagement involves building consensus, dialogue, research, development of written submissions, conferences, seminars/webinars, public hearing etc.
