



Supavud Saicheua was appointed chairman of the National Economic and Social Development Council (NESDC) in June 2024. He is also an advisor to Kiatnakin Phatra Financial Group following his retirement as Managing Director and Head of Research at Phatra Securities Plc. Supavud joined Phatra Finance and Securities Plc (as it was then known) in 1994. It was during these 25 years at Phatra that Supavud and his team lived through many tumultuous economic events including being on ground zero during Thailand's financial crisis in 1997. Prior to his work at Phatra, Supavud worked at the Ministry of Foreign Affairs where he was posted to Washington D.C. as the Thai Embassy's Economic Officer during 1986-90. In his varied positions at Thailand's Ministry of Foreign affairs during 1978-1994, Supavud participated in bilateral and multilateral talks including the Uruguay Round of Multilateral Trade Negotiations. Supavud earned his Ph.D. from the University of Hawaii at Manoa in 1984.
