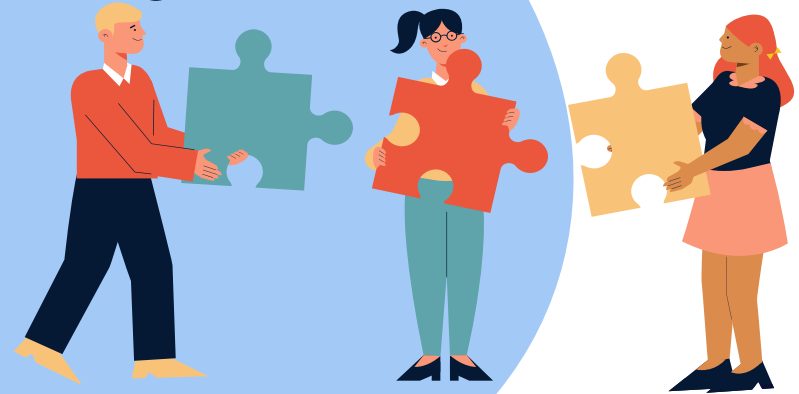

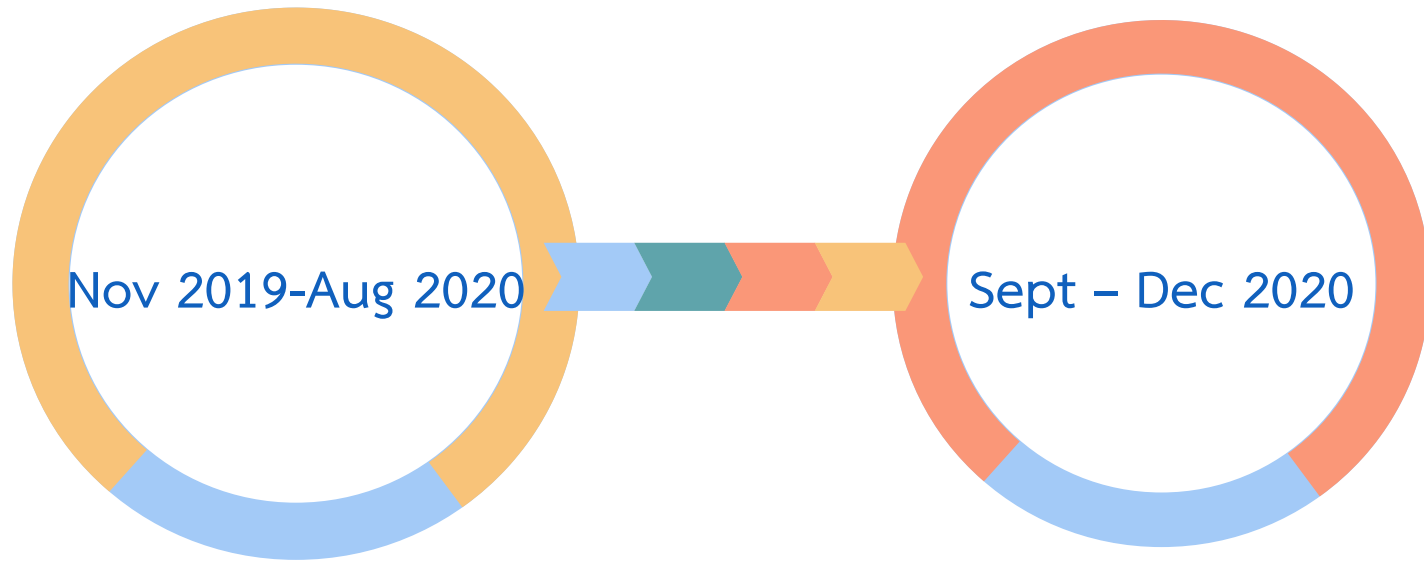

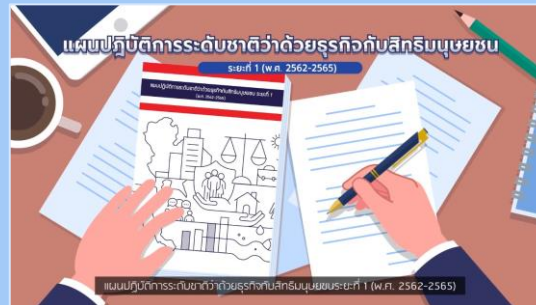

Key Achievements



- Incentives for businesses (encourage the employment of released inmates)
- Labour administration and management during COVID-19
- Promote gender equality and non discrimination in workplaces



- SEC to encourage listed companies to disclose the information including human rights by 2021
- Set up Mediation Center at the community level across the country



- Amending Witness Protection Act to broaden the protection to HRDs
- Study concrete measures to protect HRDs and Anti-SLAPP law



- NEDA to include human rights evaluation in the contract before approving loan to CMLV projects
- Include mandate to provide suggestion to business-related violation case to the NAP National Committee (inbound and outbound investment)
- Bank of Thailand to develop MOU to promote sustainable financing and ESG

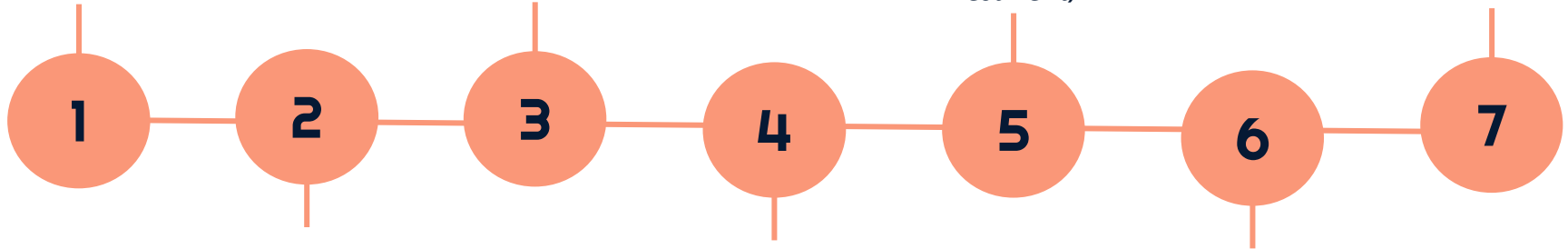
