Mrs. Auramon SUPTHAWEETHUM started her career in 1990 working as a trade negotiator and an economist at the Department of Business Economics, currently called the Department of Trade Negotiations, the Ministry of Commerce of Thailand. She represented Thailand in several World Trade Organization (WTO) and bilateral trade negotiations and meetings, particularly in the rules and agriculture negotiations.

She was Minister Counselor at the Permanent Mission of Thailand to the World Trade Organization from 2003-2007.

Mrs. Auramon joined the Department of Intellectual Property in 2007 as the Head of the FTA/WTO Unit and later became the Director of the Intellectual Property Promotion Office focusing on IP promotion and international cooperation, including the negotiation on intellectual property (IP) issues in the World Trade Organization, the World Intellectual Property Organization (WIPO) and Thailand's FTAs.

Mrs. Auramon became the Deputy Director-General of the Department of Intellectual Property, the Ministry of Commerce of Thailand in February 2015. She worked to improve the efficiency of IP protection and registration service and to promote the IP creation and commercialization to the business community in Thailand.

From October 2015 to July 2017 she was appointed the member of the National Reform Steering Assembly (NRSA) where she particularly worked on recommendations for economic reform with a view to transforming Thailand to Innovative-Driven- Economy.

Mrs. Auramon was appointed the Deputy Director-General of the Department of Trade Negotiations, the Ministry of Commerce of Thailand in March 2017. and in January 2018, Mrs. Auramon has been appointed the Director-General of the Department of Trade Negotiations.

Mrs. Auramon SUPTHAWEETHUM graduated with the Bachelor of Commerce and Administration in Accounting and Economics from Victoria University of Wellington, New Zealand and further her studies in Economic Development and International Trade at University of Reading, United Kingdom as well as got her Master of Business Administration from Thammasat University, Thailand.
